Battery Park City: Best known for its really nice movie theater and, well, that's pretty much it, fun-wise. But that's nothing a few cocktails can't fix, and that's exactly what's happening with the addition of a few key bars to the hood, including The Dead Rabbit and Black Hound Bar & Lounge. The Hound is the work of the Mulberry Project's cocktail honcho, Jeremy Strawn, who's thrown down the gauntlet, cocktail-speaking: The menu has a literary bent, with drinks like the Curse of Lono (Hunter S. Thompson), Hour Glass (Yeats) and Moveable Feast (you know this one) -- plus a Manhattan that's been barrel-aged for 100 days. There's also eclectic grub like paté and flatbreads, all served in a speakeasy vibe that'll suit both aspiring scribes and local bankers alike.
